

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. "Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed." Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - o Toys must be non-audible
 - o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - o Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring. • A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time (Note: This section only needs to be published in the Premium List if the Club is offering FEO.)

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entries close 6 PM, February 19 2020, at the Trial Secretary's address OR when the limit is reached, if prior to that date, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted except as provide for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. # 2020034614-15-16-17

 This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age and older that are registered with the AKC or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dogs physical or mental performance

Opening day is Dec 30 2020 6 AM.
Closes February 19 2020 6 PM
 Entries will NOT be accepted unless left WITHOUT signature required. Entries received before the opening time and date MUST be returned to sender.
 Per AKC rules: Only 10 ENTRIES maximum per envelope.
 No hand delivered entries will be accepted for the first 24 hours the trial is open. Entries received opening day must include postage or be metered or be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, DHL. Any entries not meeting the above requirements must be returned.
 For fast acknowledgment of entry, enclose a SASE or e-mail address.
 FAX ENTRIES OR FAXED MOVE-UPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
 All entries will be acknowledged after entries close with a judging program.
 Should acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

AWARDS
 Double strip ribbons for placements in each class and division Novice, Open & Excellent provided they have earned a qualifying score. Each qualifying run will earn a dark green ribbon. A MACH & PACH bar and rosette will be offered to any team completing their title at these trials. A new title neck ribbon will be offered to any exhibitor completing a title at these trials. No unclaimed awards or ribbons will be mailed.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE ADC is located 5 miles north of I69 on Lapeer Rd **BEHIND** the Moose Lodge
From the Detroit area... 175 North to Lapeer Rd Exit #81. Go north on Lapeer Rd for approx 25 miles, ADC will be on your right. (other than the first 10 miles, this road doesn't have that many lights on it and speed limit is 50mph in most cases.) or take I75 to I69 and go east to Exit #155 north
From Port Huron area, take I69 West to the Lapeer Rd Exit #155, go north 5 miles ADC will be on our right

MEASURING
 Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" and 24C" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Telephone or telegraphed entries, conditioned entries, and/or photocopied entries without the AKC agreement on the back are not acceptable. Incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and cannot be entered in the show. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Section 4)
- No entry shall be made and no entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- 75% refund entry for bitches in season, whose owner supplies the club with a letter from their vet stating she is in estrus before the the day of the trial that the dog is entered in before the start of the first class or physically checked by a member of the committee. No other refunds after closing for any reason. Don't ask!
- Make checks and money orders payable to Oakland County KC (OCKC) in U.S. funds. OCKC is not responsible for cash sent in mail. Post-dated or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service fee for returned checks in addition to any bank charges/fees. All future entries made by the person will be put on a CASH ONLY or MONEY ORDER only basis.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with an **EMAILED** confirmation and judging program. Oakland County Kennel club may decline any entries and may remove any dog because of disease, **viciousness or aggression toward people or other dogs** or other cause and no one shall have any claim against OCKC, or any official thereof or any persons assisting with this show. Any aggressive behavior will be a reason to file a formal complaint to AKC.
- Errors on entry forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whosoever may make such errors, and no entry shall be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of such entries after the closing date.
- Please type or print carefully the information on the entry form to eliminate errors.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, in season, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Agility Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance, or other act beyond the control of the Agility Show Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. OCKC will not be responsible, nor is it obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Conflicts will be handled on an individual basis.
- All dogs must be held on leash or confined except when being judged and when in the warm up or exercise area. The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dog is familiar with & able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the show site.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials.
- NO alcoholic beverages on premises.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Michigan requires an official interstate health certificate or official certificate of veterinary inspection. Also a Rabies vaccination by a licensed veterinarian within one year/three years (according to vaccine label directions). Certificate is valid for 30 days from date of examination. Airline certificates are valid for 30 days from date of examination.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
